The From Roots to Wings video presents factual and practical information about sensory processing disorders. Topics include difficulties in motor coordination/planning, self-regulation and sensory defensiveness. The major focus of the video is on strategies for addressing these sensory concerns with children shown doing sensory activities which help them to be successful in daily life and to feel good about themselves. Parents and others will gain knowledge about the subtle and often puzzling behaviors of children with sensory processing disorders.
